

# Juicy Pear Hat

## SIZE

To fit an innocent smoothie

## YARN

Any DK weight yarn in light green, and a small amount of brown

## YOU WILL ALSO NEED

A pair of 3.75mm (UK9/US5) Pony knitting needles

**deramores**

## TENSION

Tension is not critical for this project

## ABBREVIATIONS

<b>K</b>	knit
<b>P</b>	purl
<b>CO</b>	cast on
<b>sts</b>	stitches
<b>st st</b>	stocking stitch
<b>M1</b>	make a stitch by picking up the loop between 2 stitches
<b>k2tog</b>	knit two together
<b>SSK</b>	Slip first stitch, knit 2nd stitch and pass slip stitch over knitted stitch
<b>K3tog</b>	knit three together

## PATTERN

### Hat

- Using 3.75mm needles cast on 29sts in light green
- **Row 1:** K1 P1 to last st, K1
- **Row 2:** P1 K1 to last st, P1
- Work 10 rows st st in light green
- **Next row:** (K2 K2 tog) repeat to last st, K1 (22 sts)
- Work 6 rows in stocking stitch
- **Next row:** (P1 P2tog) repeat to last st P1 (15sts)
- **Next row:** (K2tog) repeat to last st, K1 (8sts)  
Change to brown
- **Next row:** K2tog 4 times then work and icord for 6 rows and cast off. There are lots of videos on YouTube that can show you how to do an icord

### Leaf

- CO 3 st
- **Row 1:** K1 M1 k1 M1 k1 (5sts)
- **Row 2:** Purl
- **Row 3:** K2 M1 k1 M1 K2 (7sts)
- **Row 4:** Purl
- **Row 5:** Knit
- **Row 6:** Purl
- **Row 7:** K1 SSK K1 k2tog K1 (5sts)
- **Row 8:** Purl
- **Row 9:** SSK K1 K2tog (3sts)
- **Row 10:** Purl
- **Row 11:** K3tog and fasten off

## MAKING UP

Sew up pear and attach leaf. Sew in all ends
